### About the Presenter

As president and CEO of Scripps Health since 2000, Chris Van Gorder has been instrumental in positioning the \$3 billion integrated San Diego health system among the nation's foremost health care institutions.

Board certified in health care management and an American College of Healthcare Executives (ACHE) Fellow, Van Gorder also served as 2010 chairman of the association – an international professional society of more than 40,000 health care executives who lead hospitals, health care systems and other health care organizations.
